On October 4, 2021, at 8:37 p.m., UCI experienced a campuswide power outage, which affected many buildings. Power was restored to the campus at 11:01 p.m. A brief walkthrough of campus buildings was conducted.

In the morning, when researchers arrive in their labs, they should verify that critical systems including fume hoods, biosafety cabinets, and ultra-low temperature freezers have restarted automatically. If they have not, then researchers should take steps to manually restart systems and freezers.
