

Fire Safety on Campus

Heat and Ignition Sources

- ⊘ Open flames / candles / incense
- ⊘ BBQs under balconies
- ⊘ Smoking in rooms
- ⊘ Space heaters with exposed filaments
- ⊘ Leaving cooking appliances on



- ⊘ Overloading circuits or extension cords
- ⊘ Doors propped open
- ⊘ Leaving heating pads on
- ⊘ Bathroom appliance left on



Fire Extinguisher Use



Fire Extinguisher Instructions for Small Compartment Fires:

- P Pull** and twist the safety pin from handle
- A Aim** (nozzle, cone, horn) at base of fire.
- S Squeeze** the trigger handle.
- S Sweep** from side to side (watch for re-flash).



Fire Evacuation

DOs

- ☺ **Use Stairways**
- ☺ **Give Assistance to Disabled persons**
- ☺ **Slowly open cool doors**
- ☺ **Proceed to assigned Evacuation Area**
- ☺ **Dial 911**

DON'Ts

- ☹ **Avoid Elevator Use**
- ☹ **Avoid Pushing and Shoving**
- ☹ **Avoid opening hot doors**
- ☹ **Do not leave doors propped open**
- ☹ **Do not obstruct exits**

RACE

R: Rescue A: Alarm C: Confine E: Extinguish or Evacuate

Fire on the floor...

1. Alert and evacuate people in the room.
2. Close door after exiting.
3. Activate fire alarm.
4. Notify UCI Police Emergency.

Do not hang up until the call is complete.

Trapped in a room...

1. Place cloth material under door to prevent smoke from entering.
2. Repeat and close all doors between you and the fire.
3. Be prepared to signal from window. Break glass if necessary.

Caught in smoke...

1. Drop to hands and knees and crawl.
2. Hold breath as much as possible.
3. Breathe shallowly through nose and use clothing as filter.
