

Laundry and Linen Cleaning Procedures

Laundry Cleaning Precautions

Sheets, towels, and any associated linens that are in close contact with conference attendees or participants, should be washed in accordance with CDC guidelines below:.

CDC guidelines:

- Launder items using the warmest water setting
- Dry items completely on high heat
- Items should be collected, processed and restocked in accordance with established industry and CDC guidelines
- Avoid vigorous shaking dirty laundry and linens to eliminate excess contact while being transported to the laundry facility
- Staff should wear PPE, including face coverings (strongly recommended for indoor spaces) and gloves
- Staff should practice good hand hygiene and wash hands after handling laundry
