- **BE MINDFUL OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS**



- **BE AWARE OF OTHERS, AND YOUR BODY POSITION IN RELATION TO OTHERS**
- **TAKE YOUR TIME WHEN WORKING AROUND OTHERS**
- **BE DELIBERATE IN YOUR ACTIONS AND AVOID RUSHING FROM SPACE TO SPACE**
- **ASK FOR HELP WHEN MOVING ITEMS TOO HEAVY OR LARGE TO HANDLE ON YOUR OWN**
- **FOLLOW ALL APPLICABLE SOPS AND POSTED SIGNAGE**
- **IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, DIAL 911**
- **ASK YOUR SUPERVISOR QUESTIONS WHEN UNSURE OF HOW TO SAFELY PERFORM A TASK**
