

UCI Motorized Cart Safety



Motorized Carts are a necessary mode of transportation for many organizations and are used to accomplish a variety of work related tasks.

In an effort to increase the safety of staff, students and visitors and to avoid injuries and property damage, *UCI* requires the following guidelines be observed while operating a motorized cart on campus.

Safety Guidelines



Operate Motorized Cart at a safe speed. Drive only as fast as conditions allow.



Be mindful of road conditions. (Speed bumps, potholes, construction, uneven surfaces, etc.)



Yield to pedestrians at all times. They always have the right of way.



Do not exceed passenger capacity of cart. Only use designated seating areas for transporting passengers.



Operate carts only in designated areas and only on authorized roads.



Inspect motorized cart before
use! Do not operate cart if any
maintenance issues are observed. Ensure
cart is repaired by qualified personnel prior
to going back into service.



Ensure all passengers wear seat belts. (If available)



Avoid distractions while operating a motorized cart. Do not text while operating cart.



Use extreme caution when:

- Making a U-turn
- Approaching an intersection
- Driving in parking lots, roadways or crowded areas



Remain seated and keep all limbs in the vehicle while in motion.

UCI Motorized Cart Safety Guidelines

At UCI:

- Only operate carts on roads with speed limits below 35 MPH
- Do not drive carts on Aldrich Park Pathways
- Cart operators must have a valid California driver's license
- Do not park motorized carts in front of emergency equipment or building entrances or exits
- Cart operators are responsible for the safe operation of the vehicle.
- Report any cart incidents / accidents to EH&S
- Be familiar with cart operation before use
- Be aware of surroundings. Look before backing up
- Use the bike lane when driving motorized carts on roads.
- Do not allow bike or skateboard riders to hold onto motorized cart while in motion
- You may park motorized carts in any of the following:
 - Service Stalls
 - "C" or General Parking
 - AR Parking

AND ALWAYS YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS

Stay on roads with speed limits below 35 MPH 35

Do not block exits / entrances

Use the bike lane when driving on the road.

UCI Motorized Cart Safety

Daily Inspections

The motorized cart daily inspection is a quick **30-second** walk around of the cart to identify obvious issues.

Below you will find a daily checklist guide that will aid you in identifying issues prior to operating the cart. Daily inspections are key to accident prevention. Any observed issues should be immediately reported, documented, and corrected.

1. Tires, Steering Wheel, Brakes, or Accelerator			If "no", notify your supervisor to initiate repairs & place the cart out of service.	
2. Cart Frame (i.e. No loose parts or fluid leaks, etc.)			If "no", notify your supervisor to initiate repairs & place the cart out of service.	
3. Charge Mechanism (i.e. battery and charger)			If the battery is not working, notify your supervisor to initiate repairs & place the cart out of service . If the charger is not working, notify your supervisor to initiate repairs/replacement.	
4. Does the cart have sufficient charge for the planned trip?			If "no", charge cart prior to use.	
5. Does the cart have a label/number assigned?			If "no", notify your supervisor to email safety@uci.edu & request a cart label.	
6. Does the cart label <u>start</u> <u>with two letters</u> ?			If "no", notify your supervisor to email safety@uci.edu & request a new cart label.



1. Turn Signals (LT & RT)				If "no" or "not equipped", <u>use hand signals</u> for turns. For repairs, notify your supervisor.			
2. Brake Lights				If "no" or "not equipped", <u>use hand signals</u> for brakes. For repairs, notify your supervisor.			
3. Headlights				If "no" or "not equipped", do not operate cart if headlights are needed to view the road ahead (i.e. driving at night or before dawn). For repairs, notify your supervisor.			
4. Emergency Lights				If "no" or "not equipped", park safely & do not obstruct pathways. For repairs, notify your supervisor.			
5. Reverse Audible Signal				If "no" or "not equipped", <u>use additional precaution</u> when reversing. For repairs, notify your supervisor.			
6. Strobe Lights				If "no" or "not equipped", <u>use additional precaution</u> when approaching pedestrians/vehicles. For repairs, notify your supervisor.			
7. Horn				If "no" or "not equipped", <u>use callouts and additional precaution</u> when driving. For repairs, notify your supervisor.			
8. Seat Belts				If "no" or "not equipped", <u>use additional precaution</u> when driving. For repairs, notify your supervisor.			
9. Mirrors				If "no" or "not equipped", <u>use additional precaution</u> when driving. For repairs, notify your supervisor.
